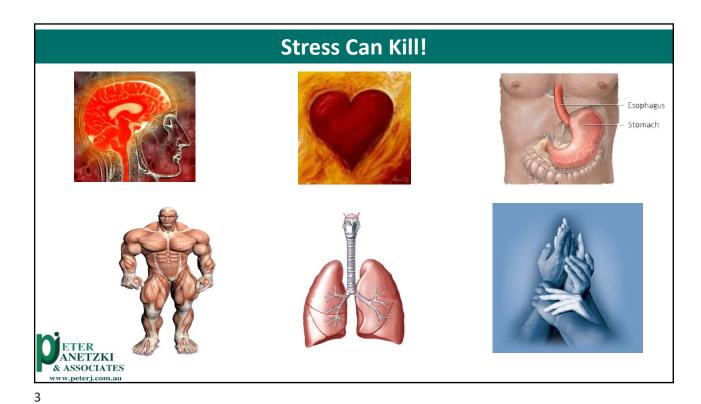


Stress Quick Quiz

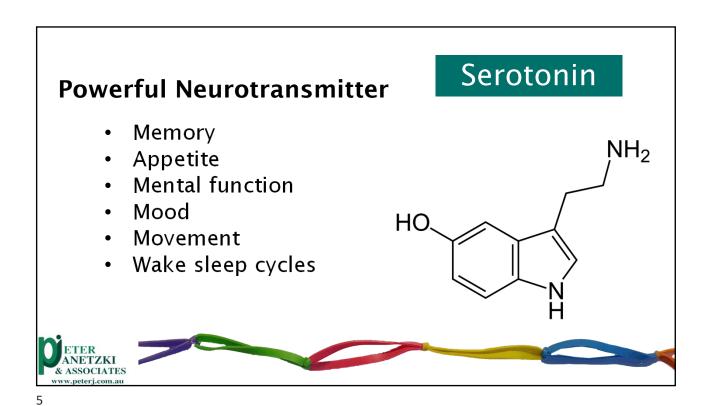

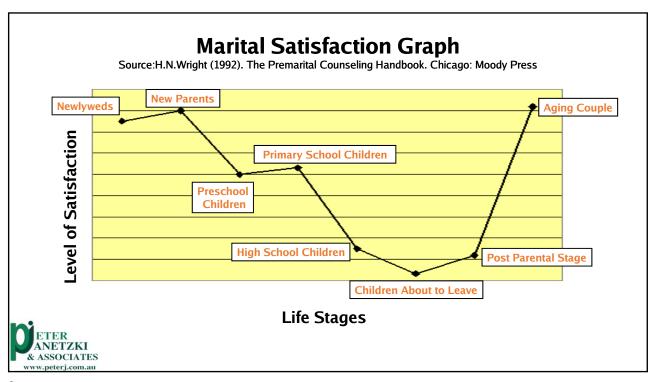

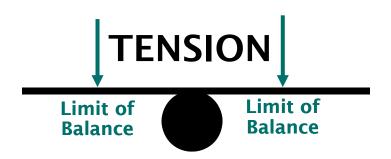

MANAGING TENSION is the key to staying BALANCED

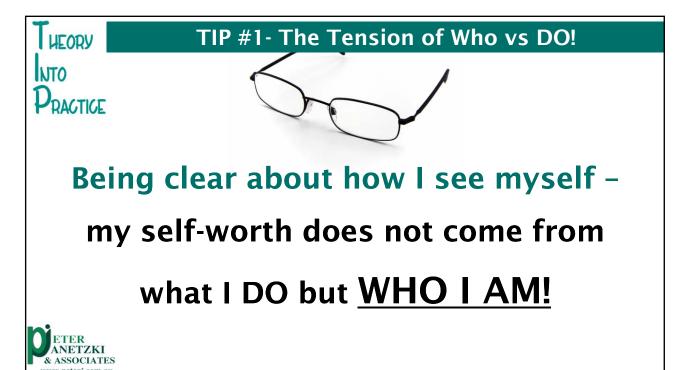


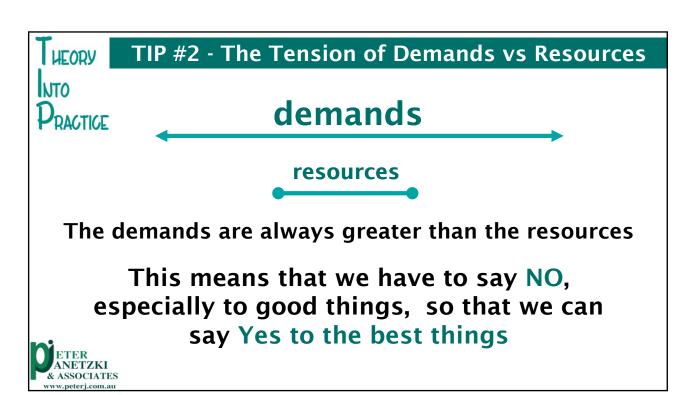


To keep it BALANCED we have to hold the TENSION by staying within the LIMITS

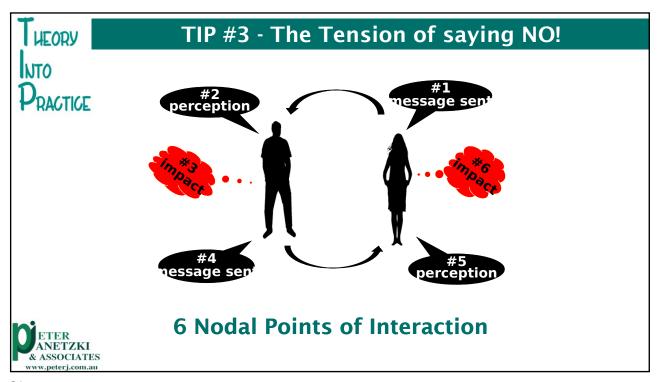


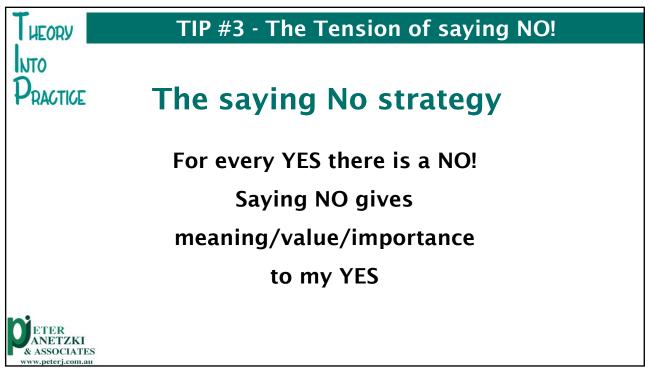
