**RE: Chinese Culture Experience Tour 2020** 

Brisbane Christian College is delighted to have been invited by the Shandong Government of China to participate in a Cultural Tour of China again next year. Proposed dates for this tour are 25 March, 2020 to 6 April, 2020.

This is a fantastic opportunity for Year 7-11 children studying (or planning to study) Chinese in 2020 to be immersed in the Chinese environment experiencing the culture in its entirety: language, people and customs as well as visiting its breathtaking scenic spots and landmarks.

The tour is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity because a portion of the costs will be borne by the Shandong Government of China as they extend their cultural and educational program to Australia and connect with local schools. As such, we are able to offer this 13- day, all-inclusive tour for only \$1590.

The tour will be headed by our College Deputy Principal, Mr Ross Eggins, our Chinese Teacher, Miss Claire Li, and other staff members.

Please read the attached information carefully to decide if this opportunity is right for your child. To reserve your student's place, please return the completed permission form, together with a non-refundable deposit of \$590.00 by Friday, 26 July 2019 to the College Office.

Please note, that by sending your child on this trip, it is expected that you would be willing to host a student from China when they visit Australia in June next year. Hosting international students is exciting and rewarding. Besides the obvious benefits of cultural and language enrichment, it can also supplement the family income. These students typically stay for 7-10 days in January-February and June-August.

Places on this trip are limited to 16 students, so please return this form as soon as possible to avoid disappointment.

#### **Details of the China Tour**

Eligibility: Year 7 to Year 11 students (subject to application process)

Applications due: 26/7/19

Tour size: 16 students

Length: 13 days

Date: 25/3/19 - 6/4/19

Cost: \$1590

This cost includes transportation, homestay, most meals and study materials.

It does not include travel insurance and personal expenses.

Payment: \$590 on registration (closes on 26/07/19). This amount is non-refundable.

Remaining balance of \$1000 to be paid in full by 16/9/19.

Travel insurance: This is mandatory and is the responsibility of the student and their family.

Visas: The College will organise the Visa application for the children. It will require copies of their current passport.

Passport: Passport needs to be valid for at least 6 months from the date of travel. If your child does not have a passport, this will need to be organised as soon as possible. A passport application costs from \$139.00 and application forms can be obtained from Australia Post. The application process is estimated at 3 weeks, and a passport is necessary for the Visa Application.

Accommodation: homestay families in Shandong, screened and selected by Shandong Family Cultural Education Development Centre, Shandong Government.

Currency: Currently 1 AUD: 4.77 CNY

Weather: generally dry in March and April with an average temperature of 10-20°C

Clothing: formal school uniform with leather shoes, a thick warm jacket, a warm sweater, warm pants or legging (for girls), warm socks and closed in shoes, toiletries, personal clothing, bath towels, personal medication, small amount of money for personal expenses (no more than \$150AUD).

Souvenirs for Homestay Family: no more than \$10, preferably not food.

If you are interested in your child attending the Chinese Cultural Exchange, please complete the attached permission slip and application form and return it to the College office by Friday, 26 July 2019, along with the \$590 deposit.
